Our 125th Anniversary is bringing a number of exciting changes that are focused on improving student engagement and Building on our Heritage of Care, including:

- * The establishment of our new library space on the first floor of Clark Center
- * Shift of the old student center space and model to the new Charlotte Shultz Learning Commons and Student Engagement Center on the 2nd floor of Clark Center.

These areas will include state-of-the-art learning and collaboration spaces with upgraded technology and additional study/collaboration areas for the entire NMC community.

There will be a number of informational sessions held for the NMC family beginning on Monday, October 19th from 12-1 in the Clark Center-Hood Lobby.

On Monday, from 12-1, we will have displays with renderings and personnel from our partner Steelcase to share the excitement of our plans. 1:00 pm to 1:30 pm - representatives from SBI and Steelcase will walk through the projects with student leaders from Student Government and Ambassadors; and 1:30pm to 2:30 pm- the representatives will host an informational session for anyone from the campus community to learn more about the project and ask questions of the experts. Additional informational sessions will also be held from Noon-1 on Wednesday the 21st and Friday the 23rd.
