ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS² *(Application required. Deadline 1/11/2021.)*

The Kathleen Montgomery ACE Scholarship provides an award of \$7,500 for one year (\$2,500 each term). One-half of the scholarships awarded each year will be based on academic merit and one-half based on demonstrated financial need as determined by the FAFSA.

Scholarship funding is limited and distributed based upon deposit date and FAFSA filing date. Complete the FAFSA and our scholarship application to be considered for this prestigious award.

OTHER OPPORTUNITIES^{2,3}

- **HOSA Leadership Scholarship** - \$1,000 one-time award for active members of high school HOSA chapter
- **Legacy Grant** - \$2,000 one-time award for a sibling of a current NMC student, or a sibling or dependent child of an NMC alumnus
- **Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship** - \$1,000 one-time award for initiated members
- **United Methodist Church Member Award** - \$1,000 one-time award for active UMC congregation members
